We are often given the statistics of a phenomenon and are then called upon to draw conclusions. We sometimes assume that the data were obtained as they were because the law of large numbers must apply. This assumption is wrong. The law of large numbers is actually a phenomenon itself. It describes a typical statistical relationship and may be used to estimate parameters of the law, but it is not a law. Since most applied statisticians use too much data to arrive at a statistically valid conclusion, there is a growing need for good statistical estimates and critical thinking skills.
